

You have requested information concerning our use of recycled products in the production of your ordered parts. These are specific to the "LEED Green Building Rating System". There are two categories,

1. Percent of post-consumer recycled content, and
2. Percent of post-industrial recycled content.

Sapa, Delhi is considered a secondary melting/casting facility with respect to the aluminum starting stock used to extrude the aluminum shape(s) you order. This means that all raw materials are re-melted prior to alloying and casting of the specific size and alloy required producing your ordered product versus using original molten smelter material, i.e., a primary facility.

In General we utilize 20 % post-consumer material and approximately 30 % post-industrial material in the manufacture of this extrusion starting stock.

The mixture of scrap and prime in our billet can vary depending upon specific customer requests, dimensions of the profile, and other production related issues.
